

Program Eligibility

Competitive applicants typically meet the following:

- Currently enrolled as a junior in high school
- Planning to apply to college during senior year
- Mostly A's in the most challenging courses offered at a student's high school
- Highly ranked amongst graduating class
- SAT or PSAT score of 1250+ / ACT or Pre-ACT score of 26+ (optional)

- Extracurricular leadership, family responsibilities, and/or part-time work
- Identify as a student of color and/or first-generation college goer
- A commitment to our two 6-week residential **Summer Academies**

We review all applications holistically and do not have a GPA requirement.
